K. CITY COUNCIL BUSINESS - COMMUNITY/EC DEVELOPMENT (GRAY)

3. AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 1094

City staff discovered a clerical error in Ordinance No. 1094 (Nobles County Recorder's Office Document #350997). Section II. of the Ordinance incorrectly stated that the subject property would hereby be classified as "R-5". The intent of the ordinance was to rezone the subject property to "B-3". The title of the Ordinance was correct and all discussions at the Planning Commission and at the City Council meetings prior to and at the time of the adoption of Ordinance No. 1094 pertained to a change to a "B-3" district. The City Attorney has prepared a resolution designed to correct this error. This resolution is included in *Exhibit 3A* and staff would request a motion to pass this resolution.

4. <u>CONSIDERATION OF REMOVAL OF PLANNING COMMISSION</u> MEMBER

Bob Bristow, Chairman of the City's Planning and Zoning Commission, had contacted the City Clerk in September of this year regarding several absences of member Jessica Velasco from Planning Commission meetings. The Clerk issued a letter to Ms. Velasco regarding her absences and requesting her attendance at the meetings. When no response was received, personal contact was made by Steve Robinson, City Administrator. Ms. Velasco responded verbally to him that she wished to remain on the Commission and would strive to attend the meetings.

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Staff has again been approached by the Planning Commission Chairman with a request to remove Ms. Velasco from the Commission due to her continued lack of attendance at the meetings. Planning Commission meeting minutes show that Ms. Velasco has attended three of the last 12 meetings of the Commission. Ms. Velasco has also failed to provide prior notification of an impending absence in many of the instances.

Section 151.01 of the Worthington City Code states "Six members shall be appointed by the City Council and may be removed by a four-fifths vote of the Council." The Planning Commission By Law guidelines state: "Membership Removal - Any member may be removed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council for cause after a hearing."

City Attorney Mark Shepherd advises that Council should consider the request from the Planning Commission Chairman, and if it is determined to move forward, Council should set the time and date for the hearing as 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 26, 2017, at the next regular City Council meeting. Ms. Velasco will be provided notice of the hearing and an opportunity to be heard. Staff has informed Ms. Velasco that this request is before Council.

WHEREAS, attached hereto as Exhibit 'A' is a copy of Ordinance No. 1094 which amended a portion of Title XV of the City Code so as to re-zone certain property within the City to "B-3."; and

WHEREAS, the Title of Ordinance No. 1094 is correct; and

WHEREAS, all discussions at the Planning Commission and at the City Council meetings prior to and at the time of the adoption of Ordinance No. 1094 pertained to a change to a "B-3" district; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 1094 contained a scrivener's error in Section II. wherein it is stated that:

"The following legally described area, presently included in the "R-1", "R-5", "B-3" and "B-4" districts, shall henceforth be included in the "R-5" district:; and

WHEREAS, Section II. of said Ordinance No. 1094 should have stated:

"The following legally described area, presently included in the "R-1", "R-5", "B-3" and "B-4" districts, shall henceforth be included in the "B-3" district:; and

WHEREAS, the legal description of the subject property is set forth on Exhibit 'B' which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance No. 1094, the City has treated the subject property as being located in a "B-3" district and the official City Zoning Map designates the property as being located in a "B-3" district;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED:

- 1. The error set forth in Section II. of Ordinance No. 1094 referencing "R-5" district is hereby corrected so as to reference "B-3" district.
- 2. The City ratifies all decisions made subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance No. 1094 as to the property affected by the error so as to be in conformity with the intended purpose of the Ordinance which is to classify such property as being located in a "B-3" district and that it shall be considered that Ordinance No. 1094 was originally written as intended.

ORDINANCE NO. 1094

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE XV OF THE CITY CODE OF WORTHINGTON, NOBLES COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO REZONE PROPERTY FROM "R-1" (ONE FAMILY DETACHED RESIDENTIAL), "R-5" (MULTI-FAMILY, MEDIUM AND HIGH DENSITY RESIDENTIAL), "B-3" (GENERAL BUSINESS) AND "B-4" (SHOPPING CENTER) TO "B-3" (GENERAL BUSINESS)

The City Council of the City of Worthington, Do Ordain:

Section I

In order to better protect and enhance public health, safety and general welfare, the Worthington City Council hereby finds that it is necessary to modify the zoning district designation of certain areas of the City of Worthington from "R-1" - One Family Detached Residential, "R-5" - Multi-Family Medium and High Density Residential, "B-3" - General Business, and "B-4" - Shopping Center to "B-3" - General Business.

Section II.

The following legally described area, presently included in the "R-1", "R-5", "B-3" and "B-4" districts, shall henceforth be included in the "R-5" district:

A tract of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 102 North, Range 40 West, City of Worthington, Nobles County, Minnesota described as follows:

Commencing at the South Quarter Corner of said Section 13; thence North 00 degrees 01 minutes 10 seconds East, along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 13, a distance of 67.00 feet to the southeast corner of NORTHLAND MALL FIRST ADDITION according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Nobles County Recorder and the point of beginning; thence continuing North 00 degrees 01 minutes 10 seconds East a distance of 770.15 feet to the northeast corner of said NORTHLAND MALL FIRST ADDITION; thence North 89 degrees 03 minutes 04 seconds West, along the north line of said NORTHLAND MALL FIRST ADDITION, a distance of 420.21 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 5, FIRST RESURVEY AND RESUBDIVISION OF NORTHLAND MALL FIRST ADDITION according to the recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Nobles County Recorder; thence North 00 degrees 04 minutes 26 seconds East, along the east line of said Lot 5, a distance of 430.26 feet; thence South 00 degrees 01 minutes 34 seconds East, along the west line of said Lot 5, a distance
