

With popularity on the rise for **ELECTRIC SCOOTERS**, here's what you need to know:

Scooters follow the same rules as bikes (mostly!)

1. No riding on sidewalks (except to enter/leave property)



2. One rider only—no passengers allowed



3. Age 12+ to ride, and helmets are required if you're under 18

12+



4. Lights are a must when it's dark



5. Left turns? Hop off and walk it across!



6. Stick to bike lanes, paths, and the right side of the road



7. Stay off pedestrian-only paths



Minnesota State Statute 169.225 covers the use and operation of these foot scooters.
